**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
FIRE DISTRICT NO.1 BOROUGH OF JAMESBURG DECLARING
A 2004 CHEVROLET BLAZER MOTOR VEHICLE EXCESS
PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS CONVEYANCE TO
THE HELMETTA FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS; The Board of Fire Commissioners owns a 2004 CHEVROLET BLAZER motor vehicle which has been in continual service since its acquisition; and

WHEREAS; The Board has been advised by the Chief of the Jamesburg Volunteer Fire Company that said vehicle has been removed from service and replaced by a new vehicle thereby rendering this vehicle excess property no longer needed for fire protection; and

WHEREAS; N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36 (2) provides that the governing body of any municipal contracting unit may transfer personal property no longer needed for public use to another public body without advertising for bids; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No.1 Borough of Jamesburg that the above specified vehicle is hereby declared excess property no longer needed for public use and may be transferred to the Helmetta Fire Department gratis.
